2.	Recent academic transcript whether it be from a high school, college, university, or trade school.
	<u>CURRENT COLLEGE FRESHMAN</u> - Judges will screen and require more than one semester or quarter of grades. If this applies to you, submit your high school transcript.
3.	Copy of your college entrance examination (ACT and/or SAT) scores. (College Freshman Only.)
