HOW TO SPOT A UTILITY SCAM



Verify the Source

- **Direct contact:** Always verify the source of any communication by contacting Mor-Gran-Sou Electric Cooperative directly using a trusted phone number or website.
- **Representative identification:** Ask for identification or a callback number if someone claims to be from our cooperative.
- **Red flags**: Be wary of grammar and spelling errors, generic greetings, and unusual payment methods (like gift cards).

Recognize Scam Tactics

- **Unsolicited payment requests:** Mor-Gran-Sou Electric will not demand immediate payment over the phone or via prepaid cards.
- **Threats of disconnection:** Be cautious of threats of immediate service disconnection if payment isn't made. Mor-Gran-Sou Electric will provide multiple notices before taking such action.
- **Personal information requests**: Mor-Gran-Sou Electric will not typically ask for sensitive personal information (like Social Security numbers or bank account details) over the phone or via email.

- **Report suspicious activity:** Report any suspicious utility related scams to Mor-Gran-Sou Electric at 701–597–3301, 800–750–8212 or 701–663–0297.
- **Stay Informed:** Keep updated on common scam tactics and warnings issued by Mor-Gran-Sou Electric and consumer protection agencies.
