Mor-Gran-Sou Electric Cooperative, Inc. (MGS) is a member-owned grassroots organization serving member-consumers residing in Morton, Grant, and Sioux counties in south central North Dakota. The electric transmission and distribution cooperative has service centers in Flasher, Fort Yates, and Mandan.

MGS has an opening for a Seasonal Apprentice Lineworker. Under direct supervision of a Journeyman, this position constructs and repairs electric distribution and transmission line of the cooperative in efficient operating order. Install lightning arrestors, circuit breakers, regulators, transformers, and other equipment as necessary. Work on energized lines using approved gloving methods and hotline tools and respond to outage calls.

Applicants must have completed a one-year line worker training course. On-the-job training records will be maintained. Apprentice lineworker will always work under direct supervision of Journeyman until certification requirements are completed. A valid North Dakota Commercial Driver's license (CDL), including air brake endorsement, or ability to obtain within 90 days of hire, is required. Must be willing to become or maintain qualifications in basic first aid, CPR, and pole top rescue.
